**Aleksandar Stojanovic**

**Today, 14th December, 2015**

**The Court;**

Having seen the accusations brought against **Aleksandar Stojanovic**, holder of identity card no. 62335A;

Accused with having on these islands on the 11<sup>th</sup> December 2015 at about half past six in the afternoon (6.30pm) from inside vehicle make Land Rover, bearing registration number CBT 901 which was in Marguerite Mangion Street, St. Julian's and/or in the vicinity:

Committed theft of a bag containing a mobile phone make iPhone costing Euro 400, two mobile phones make Nokia

worth Euro 50 each, GPS make Tomtom which cost Euro 600 and a small camera which cost Euro 50 to the detriment of Christopher Aquilina and/or other persons, and/or other entities which theft is aggravated by 'amount' (which exceeds two hundred and thirty-two Euro and ninety-four cents (€232.94) but does not exceed two thousand and three hundred and twenty-nine Euro and thirty-seven cents (€2,329.37), 'time' and 'nature of things stolen'.(Art. 261 (c), (f), (g), 267, 270, 271 (g), 279 (a) of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta).

Accused also for rendering himself a recidivist as per article 49 and 50 of Chap 9 of the Laws of Malta, by judgments which have become absolute by foreign Courts.

Having seen all the documents exhibited by the prosecution;

Having seen the records of the case;

Having explained to the accused the charges against him;

Having heard the accused plead guilty to said charges in today's sitting, and this in the presence of Defence Counsel Dr. Leontine Calleja, thus upon such guilty plea the Court can only find the accused guilty as charged;

Having warned the accused of the legal consequences of such guilty plea and having given the accused further time to reconsider his guilty plea and having heard the accused reconfirm his guilty plea and thus said guilty plea was registered in the acts of today's sitting, the 14<sup>th</sup> December 2015;

Having seen the conduct sheet of the accused representative only of his conduct during his stay in Malta;

Therefore the Court, having seen Articles 261(c), (f) and (g), 267, 270, 271 (g), 279 (a), 49 and 50 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta, commits the accused to a term of imprisonment of nine (9) months from today.
