vs

Abdulkadir Mohamud Abdihukun

The Court;

After having seen the charges brought against:

Abdulkadir Mohamud Abdihukun, 28 years, son of Abdulkadir and Amina Mohamed, born Somalia, on the 1st January 1987, residing St. Joseph, Flat 5, Triq San Gorg, Safi, and holder of ID Card no 55168A.

And charge him with having on the 04th August 2015 in Luqa and various places on these islands;

Committed aggravated theft of vehicle, Toyota Hilux bearing registration number JAU 124 which theft is aggravated by amount, time, means and nature of the thing stolen to the detriment of Toussaint Azzopardi;

And charge him also with having during the same time, place and circumstances, with the intent to commit a crime of theft, manifested such intent by overt acts which were followed by a commencement of the execution of the crime which crime was not completed in consequence of some accidental cause independent of the will of the offender;

And charge him also with having on these islands on the 4th August 2015 driven vehicle Toyota Hilux bearing registration number JAU 124, without being covered with an insurance policy in respect of third party risks;

And charge him also with having on these islands on the 4th August 2015 driven Toyota Hilux bearing registration number JAU 124, without a licence;

And charge him also with thorough imprudence negligence or unskillfulness in his trade or profession, or through non-observance of any regulation caused damages on vehicle Toyota Hilux bearing registration number JAU 124;

And also charge him with having in a public place or place open to the public, been found drunk and incapable of taking care of himself;

And charge him also with having committed a crime whilst under a probation order which sentence was handed to him by Magistrate Dr. J.

Vella LLD on the 15th June 2015 which sentence was final, under article 7 of Chapter 446 of the laws of Malta.

Having seen the accusations being made.

Having seen the Law, being the following:

Articles 267,271, 278, 270 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta;

Article 41 (1)(a) of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta;

Article 3(1)(1A) (2)(2A)(3) of Chapter 104 of the Laws of Malta;

Article 15 (1) (a) of Chapter 65 of the Laws of Malta;

Article 338 (ff) of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta and

Article 328 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta.

Having Heard the accused admission of all accusations and having given him time to reconsider and heard him re affirmed his admission.

Upon admission and having seen all the accusations.

The Courts finds him guilty of all accusations and condemns him to a period of 12 months imprisonment.

The Court also suggests the Competent Authority to give him the necessary treatment should he suffer from any problems.
