Mohamed Ibrahim Abdalla

The Court,

Having seen the charges laid against the accused, Mohamed Ibrahim Abdalla holder of Somalian nationality with ID no 122263A accused:

1. with having on the 21st November 2015 at around 03.00hrs in St Julians or in the vicinity, without the intent to kill or to put the life in manifest jeopardy, caused grievous bodily harm on the person of Miloud Elforjani (Art 216, 218 of chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta);
2. for having on the same date, time, place and circumstances in any public place or place open to the public, was found drunk or incapable of taking care of himself;

Having seen all the documents and acts of the proceedings;

Having heard the accused plead guilty to the charges brought against him on which plea he insisted even after the Court gave him time to reconsider.

Having seen Articles 216 and 218 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta.

Decides : By application of Article 383 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta, orders the accused to keep peace with Miloud Elforjani for a period of one year under a penalty of €1,000, conditional discharge for a period of one year.

The Court explained to the accused his responsibilities according to the judgement.
