The Court,

Having seen plaintiff's application filed on the 30th October 2015 requesting that plaintiff's request for a personal separation be converted to a request for divorce.

Having seen defendant's reply filed on the 9th December 2015 where she stated that although in principle she is not opposing plaintiff's application of the 30th October 2015, submits that the requirement imposed by Article 66B (c) first needs to be fully addressed and adhered with by the plaintiff, as otherwise the request for divorce cannot be legally upheld.

Having seen the acts of the case.

Having seen **Articles 66B and 66F of Chapter 16 of the Laws of Malta.**

The Courts is of the opinion that all the requirements stipulated by Article 66B of Chapter 16 have been satisfied and therefore the request to convert the claim of personal separation is justified.

Decide

Decides as follows:

For the above reasons declares that the requirements stipuated by Article 66B of Chapter 16 have been satisfied, and by virtue of Article 66F of Chapter 16 orders that the request for personal separation be instead amended to a request for divorce.

Each party to bear his and her own costs relative to this judgment.
