The Court;

After seeing the charges brought against;

Joselyn Katherine Sanchez Roman, of 22 years of age, Ecuador national, daughter of Eduardo Sanchez and Cresaleda Angelita Roman, born in Ecuador on 6th December 1993, residing in Milan, Italy and holder of Italian Identity Card bearing number 1562968AA;

With having on the 4th January 2016, or previous days in the Police General Headquarters or somewhere else, forged, altered or tampered with a document, being an Italian Identity card bearing number AA1562988 or

used or had in her possession same document, which she knew to be forged, altered or tampered with;

Also, with having on same date, time and circumstances, committed any other kind of forgery or have knowingly made use of any other forged document mentioned above at Police General Headquarters;

And with having on same date, time and circumstances forged any document or true copy of a document or an entry made in pursuance of this act;

Considers;

After having seen Article 5 of Chapter 61, Article 189 of Chapter 9 and Article 32 of Chapter 217 of the Laws of Malta;

After having heard the evidence and the documents exhibited;

After having heard the accused admit the charges brought against her, which admission was confirmed by her after having been given time to reconsider in accordance with the law;

The Court finds the said accused guilty as charged discharges her from any punishment on condition that she does not commit another offence within the

period of three (3) years from today, in accordance with the provisions of Article 22 Chapter 446 of the Laws of Malta.

The Court explained in clear words the terms of the judgement to the accused.
