The Court;

After seeing the charges brought against Robert Stojanoski of 33 years of age, Macedonian nationality, son of Dejan & Olgica, born in Prilep, Macedonia on the 23rd November 1984, residing in Macedonia and holder of Macedonian passport bearing number B0703258;

With having on 24th January 2018 or previous days:

- 1) in order to gain any advantage or benefit for himself or others, in any document intended for any public authority, knowingly made a false declaration or statement or gave false information to the Immigration police at Malta International Airport;
- 2) Charged also with having on the same date and circumstances, made or caused to be made any false return, false statement or false representation in relation to any information to be given under or for purposes of the Immigration Act.

Having heard the accused plead guilty to the charges brought against him, notwithstanding the fact that the Court warned him in the most solemn manner of legal consequences of his guilty plea after giving him sufficient time within which to reconsider and withdraw her guilty plea;

Having heard the prosecution and defence counsel make their submissions;

Having seen all the acts and documents exhibited;

Considers;

After having seen Article 188 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta and Article 32 of Chapter 217 of the Laws of Malta;

After having heard the evidence and the documents exhibited;

The Court finds the said accused guilty and is sentencing him to six months imprisonment suspended for one (1) year in terms of Article 28A of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta.
