The Court,
Having seen the charges profferred against the accused
that on the 29th January, 2003 and during the preceding
weeks:
he had in his possession the whole or any portion of the
plant cannabis.
The Court has been requested to order the accused to
pay the expenses incurred by the Court appointed experts
in term of section 533 of the Criminal Code.

Kopja Informali ta' Sentenza

Having seen the note filed by the Attorney General during the sitting of the 31st January, 2003 whereby he gave his consent that the case be heard by a Court of Criminal Judicature.

Having seen the records of the case of the 31st January, 2003 where the accused admitted to the charge as proffered.

Consequently, the Court finds him guilty of the charge as proffered. Having seen section 8(d) of Chapter 101 of the Laws of Malta does not condemn him to a term of imprisonment but sets him free under the provisions of section 9 of Chapter 152 of the Laws of Malta on condition that he commits no other offence for a period of one year from today. The Court orders the destruction of the cannabis exhibited.
