The Court,

Has seen the charge against the above mentioned
Michael Carr charged with having on these islands of 31

August 2002 at about 06.30 a.m. in St George's Bay St Julians or in the vicinity, committed the theft of a canvas top, which item costs more than Lm 100 but less than Lm 1000, from vehicle bearing registration number LAK 771, make Maruti to the detriment of Mark S.J. Vella Muscat, Captain Morgan Leisure Ltd, and other persons, which theft is aggravated by time, amount and the nature of the thing stolen, and this in breach of Articles 267, 270, 271, of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta.

Has seen that the accused had no objection to summary proceedings and this with regards to the relative consent filed by the Attorney General.

Has seen also that on examination accused pleaded not guilty but on the 5 of March 2003 registered a plea of guilt to the said charges.

Has seen sections 261, 267, 270, 271, 279, 280, 21.

Has seen the conviction sheet of the accused, also his cooperation with the Police as results from his statement, considers also that he is a first time offender, thus considers that he should not be imprisoned, applies section 9 of Chapter 152 and discharges him on condition that he does not commit another crime three years from today.
