The Court

Having seen the accusation brought against Nicholas Bernard Delyon, 17 years of age, son of Francis and Geneviere *nee*' Watterwald, born in Clamant, France, on 1st February, 1986, and holder of passport number 00XP-91676, and charge him

Informal Copy of Judgement

With having on these Islands on the 22nd of July, 2003, and the previous days in Malta has in his possession the resin obtained from the Plant Cannabis, or any other preparation of which such resin formed the base, in terms of Section 8 (a) of the Chapter 101 of the Laws of Malta.

The Court is therefore requested to apply Section 533 (1) of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta, as regards to the expenses incurred by the Court appointed Experts.

Having seen the order of the Attorney General of Article 22 (2) Chapter 101 of the Laws of Malta for the accused to be brought and tried by this Court;

Having heard the plea of guilt.

Finds the accused guilty as charged .

Having seen article 8 (a) Chapter 101 of the Laws of Malta .

Conditionally discharge the accused with the specific condition that he does not commit any other offence within a period of nine (9) months from today in terms of article 22 Chapter 446 of the Laws of Malta.

The Court explained the obligations of the accused arising out of this judgement and orders the destruction of the exhibited drug under the supervision of Mr. Mario Mifsud.
