The Court

Having seen the accusation brought against:

**Tsvetkov Leonid**, aged 16, son of Andrej and Irina *nee'* Glotova, born in Russia on 11 August, 1987, holder of passport number 1430525;

**Tigran Arutyunyan**, aged 15, son of Oleg and Dina, born in Russia on 31 January, 1988, holder of passport number 1891090;

**Dmitri Junoshkin**, aged 15, son of Dmitri and Lvdmilla, born in Russia on 27 August, 1988, holder of passport number 4233352;

Accuse them for having on these Islands, on the 5 November, 2003, and for the past sixteen months had in your possession tae resin of the Plant Cannabis or any other preparation of which such resin formed the base, in terms of Section 8 (a) of Chapter 101 of the Laws of Malta.

The Court is also requested to apply Section 533 (1) of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta as regards to the expenses incurred by the Court appointed Experts.

Having seen the order of the Attorney General in terms of Art. 22 (2) Chapter 101 of the Laws of Malta for the accused to ne brought before the Court;

Having heard the plea of guilt.

Finds the accused guilty as charged.

Having seen art. 8 (a) of Chapter 101.

Conditionally discharged the accused with the specific condition that they do not commit any other offence within a period of one (1) year from today in terms of art. 22 Chapter 446 of the Laws of Malta.

The Court explained the obligations of the accused arising out of this judgement.
