The Court,

Has seen the charges against the abovementioned Ezechukwu Prince Okeke charged with having on these islands, on the 22nd February, 2005 at about 10.30 a.m. assaulted or resisted by violence or active force not

amounting to public violence, any person lawfully charged with a public duty namely Police Inspector Angelo Caruana when in the execution of the law or of a lawful order issued by a competent authority,

And also with having on the same date, time, place and circumstances, reviled, or threatened, or caused a bodily harm to any person lawfully charged with a public duty namely Police Inspector Angelo Caruana, while in the act of discharging his duty or because his having discharged such duty, or with intent to intimidate or unduly influence him in the discharge of such duty,

And also with having on the same date, time, place and circumstances without the intent to kill or put the life of any person namely Police Inspector Angelo Caruana in manifest jeopardy, caused him injuries of a slight nature as certified by Dr Joseph Galea MD of the Floriana Health Centre.

And finally charge him with having on the same, date, time, place and circumstances, disobeyed the lawful orders of any authority or of any person entrusted with a public service, or hindered or obstructed such person in the exercise of his duties, or otherwise, unduly interfered with the exercise of such duties, either by preventing other persons from doing what they are lawfully enjoined or allowed to do, or frustrating or undoing what has been lawfully done by other persons, or in any manner whatsoever.

Has seen that in today's sitting he has registered a plea of guilt to the charges brought against him after having been given due time to understand the plea registered.

Heard the accused under oath choose to explain the circumstances of the case leading to the charges he admitted to.

Finds him guilty after having seen sections 95, 96, 221, 338 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta. Has seen also section 17 of the same chapter.

Kopja Informali ta' Sentenza

Has seen his conviction sheet.

After also having taken in consideration the fact that the accused has been under preventive arrest for these last five weeks.

Applies section 22 of Chapter 446 and conditionally discharges him, under the condition that he is not to commit another crime within three years from today.
