The Court,

Having seen – Having heard – Having considered:

That the defendant pleaded guilty to the charges levelled against him, consequently these are to be considered as satisfactorily proven according to law;

Regarding the penalty to be applied, the Court gave due consideration to the fact that the defendant has a clean conduct sheet, that he admitted to the charges at the initial stage of the proceedings, and that he declared his willingness to pay the sum of LM30 to the Commissioner of Police, representing the damages caused by him.

On the strength of the above, this Court finds the accused guilty as charged, and after having seen Articles 17, 95, 96, 221, 325 (C) 338 (m.q. g) u 39 of Chapter.9 condemns him to the punishment of *eihteen months imprisonment suspended for a period of two years* according to Article 28A Chap.9.

Besides, the Court condemns defendant to the payment of the sum of LM30 by way of compensation for damages caused to the Commissioner of Police, within one week from today.

The Court has explained to the defendant in ordinary language the significance at law of the above Articles.

Finally, the Court considers the defendant to be an illegal immigrant under Maltese Law and orders his consequent removal from these Islands according to Section 15 of Chapter 217.
