The Court,

Having seen the charges proffered against the accused that on the 20th November, 2004 at about 4.00 p.m. in front of 'Ziggies Bar', Blacktail Street, St. Paul's Bay –
1. without intent to kill or to put the life of any person in manifest jeopardy, assaulted Paul Falzon causing him injuries of a greivous nature, as certified by different doctors;

2. on the same date, time, place and circumstances carried a cutting and pointed instrument without a licence from the Commissioner of Police;

3. on the same date, time, place and circumstances, at the time of committing a crime against the person had on his person an arm proper;

4. on the same date, time, place and circumstances attempted to use force against Paul Falzon with intent to insult, annoy and/or hurt such person or others.

The Court has been requested to provide for the security of Paul Falzon in terms of section 383 of the Criminal Code.

Having seen the note filed by the Attorney General where he gave his consent that this case be treated summarily.

Having seen the records of the case of the 4th February, 2005 where the accused admitted to the charges as proffered.

Having heard the defence counsel from the accused and the prosecution in relation to the punishment which has to be applied by the Court.

Consequently, the Courts finds the accused guilty of all the charges proffered against him. Having seen sections 214, 215, 216 and 339(1)(d) of the Criminal Code and sections 13(1) and 26(a) of Chapter 66 of the Laws of Malta. Having seen the clean conviction sheet of the accused and the fact that he admitted to the charges on the first hearing of the case, condemns him to a period of six months imprisonment. However, having seen section 28A of the Criminal Code orders that such judgement be not executed unless the accused commits another offence punishable with imprisonment within a period of one year from today. Moreover, having seen section 383 of the Criminal Code orders the accused not to approach in any way Paul Falzon for a period of one year under a penalty of one hundred Malta liri (Lm100).
