Pulizija Insp Carmel Bartolo vs Lucovic Nemanja

The Court, having seen the charges against Lukovic Nemanja. I present under arrest Lukovic Nemanja, 24 years, son of Obrad and Slobodanka nee Nikitovic born in Serbia on the 6 May 1980 and residing at Burlington Court room 710 Dragonara Road St. Julians.

Charged with having on these islands on the 29 August 2004 committed theft of objects namely money and jewellery items aggravated by the value of the thing stolen which does not exceed LM1,000 and by place to the detriment of Branco Nicolic and his wife Phyllis from Marsascala. And also with having on these islands on the same date and circumstances knowingly received or purchased any property which has been stolen, misapplied or obtained by means of any offence whether committed in Malta or abroad or knowingly took part in any manner whatsoever in the sale or disposal of same. And furthermore with having during the interval between 2 September 2004 and the previous months on these islands forged, altered or tampered with any passport or used or had in his possession any passport which he knew to be forged, altered or tampered with, being a passport of Slovenia bearing the number 00067053. And finally with having during the interval between the 2 September 2004 and the previous months on these islands knowingly made use of a forged document being a Slovenian passport bearing the number 00067053.

The Court having seen the guilty plea filed by the accused at a very early stage and the accused was given enough time to reflect on this. He did not change his view.

Having noted that the accused cooperated with the police and that the victim of the robbery has been fully compensated.

Having seen the Sections 17, 261, 267, 269(g), 334 as an alternative and 189 of Chapter 9 and Section 5 of Chapter 61, finds the accused guilty and condemns him 9 months imprisonment suspended for a period of 1 year. The Court explained Section 28A of Chapter 9. The record of the case is being sent to the Attorney General.
