Mladen Capara of 31 years son of Gojko and Danica nee' Zugic born on the 18/06/1974 in Ruma (in Ex Yugoslavia, Serb Republic), with no fixed address Holder of Passport number 004582226 and ID Card 18069774172176.

TODAY WEDNESDAY 27<sup>TH</sup> SEPTEMBER, 2005.

The Court;

Having seen the charges brought against the accused Mladen Capar where he was charged with having on the day of 27<sup>th</sup> September, 2005, from 'Euro Sport', B'Kara and 'Euro Sport, Iklin with several acts committed in pursuance of the same design, and thus;

1. For having committed simple theft of two perfumes not exceeding Lm100 (Hundred Maltes Liri) to the detriment of same establishment owners, and this in terms of sections 18 & 284 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta;
2. Furthermore I also charge him for having in Malta knowingly received or purchased any property which has been stolen, misapplied or obtained by means of any offence, whether committed in Malta or abroad, or shall knowingly take part, in any manner whatsoever, in the sale or disposal of the same, and this in terms of section 334 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta.

Having seen that the accused has pleaded guilty to the charges against him finds the accused guilty of such charges and after having considered the circumstances of the case, his cooperation with the Police in investigating the case and the fact that the stolen goods have been returned to the owners and the fact that imprisonment is not opportune this charges the accused under section 22(1) of the probation Act provided that he does not commit any other offence for a period of one year from the date here of .
