The Court;

After having seen the charges brought against Gerard John D'Amato, aged 40 years, son of Gerard Paul V and Maria nee' Jackson, born in England on the 8th of May, 1965, hold of ID card number 226 502 L, and residing at 87, St Henry Street, Sliema;

Accused of having, on the 15th June, 2005, at around 13:00hrs, in the afternoon, layed before the Executive Police an information regarding an offence knowing that

such offence has not been committed, or has falsely devised the traces of an offence in such a manner that criminal proceedings may be instituted for the ascertainment of such offence, and this according to Article 110 (2) of the Criminal Code Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta.

After having seen Article 110 (2) of Chapter of the Laws of Malta.

After having heard the accused admit to the accusations and confirmed such admission after having been given due time to reconsider his position according to Law;

The Court therefore finds the accused guilty as charged, and conditionally discharges him from any penalty on the understanding that he does not commit another offence for a period of six (6) months from today, according to Article 22 of Chapter 446 of the Laws of Malta.
