The Court:

Having seen the application filed by the Attorney General on the 22 March 2006 requesting this court to vary the decree of the Court of Magistrates as a Court of Criminal Inquiry of the 20 March 2006 whereby the three accused were granted bail under certain conditions;

Having heard counsel for the applicant Attorney General, Dr Stephen Tonna Lowell, as well as counsel for all three respondents, Dr Giannella Caruana Curran, at to-day's sitting;

Having heard also Inspector Kevin Borg on oath, as well as all three respondents (two of whom were duly assisted also by an interpreter) not under oath;

Finds that in this particular case there are no compelling reasons for the decree of the Inferior Court to be varied as is being requested;

Consequently dismisses the application, and orders that a copy of this (to-day's) decree be served forthwith upon the Attorney General and upon all three respondents.
