The Court,

Having seen the charges brought against the accused Zuzana Uzikova, 21 years, daughter of Lubomir Uzik and Eleonora Uzikova nee' Strukanova, born on 31st October 1984, Rimavska Sobota, Republic of Slovenska, residing at 69, Triq il-Qasam, Swieqi, holder of passport number 3450036 issued Republic of Slovenska, and charge her with having on these Islands on the night between 27th July 2006 and 5th July 2006, in St.Julians and other places, by means of several acts, committed at different times in pursuance of the same design and which constitute violations of the same provisions of the law:

(1) committed the theft of a mobile phone of the brand Nokia 7283, valued 400 USD, one (1) digital camera make Olympus valued unknown, cosmetics and more foreign currency which amounts over than 120 Euros but does not exceed Lm1000, and some clothes to the detriment of Ms. Angelina Firstova, Ms. Clotilde Marie Genevieve Redon, Ms. Oxana Khatsudova and Ms. Valerie Bedoucha, which theft is aggravated by time, amount and person, and this in breach of Articles 267, 268 and 270 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta;

(2) knowingly received or purchased any property which had been stolen, misapplied or obtained by means of any offence, or knowingly took part, in any manner whatsoever, in the sale or disposal of the same, and this in breach of Article 334 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta;

Having heard the evidence tendered on oath;

Having seen the record of the proceedings;

Having heard the plea of guilt by the accused for the first charge;

Having heard the admission of the same plea of guilt for the first charge by the accused, after the Court have adequate time for the accused to reconsider her plea;

Having heard the oral submissions of the parties;

Considers:-

On her same admission, the Court finds the accused guilty of the charges brought against her, and after having seen Articles 261, 267, 268, 270, 279, 280 and 28A of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta, condemns the accused for one year imprisonment suspended for three years. The Court, with reference to the second charge, acquits the accused of the same, since this charge is a subsidiary charge to the first charge brought against the same accused.
