The Court,

Saw the charges brought by the Police against Dusan Andjelovic of 20 years, son of Zoran and Ankica nee Dordevic, born in Nis, Serbia on the 30<sup>th</sup> May 1986 and residing Nis Durlanska No 9 Serbia and holder of passport no. 4125533; and

Mladen Matic of 22 years, son of Slavoljub and Verica nee Zivovic, born in Kosovo, Serbia on the 24<sup>th</sup> November 1983 and residing Pristina Vukovarska, Serbia and holder of Serbian ID no. 2411983924864 and accused them for:

Kopja Informali ta' Sentenza

Having on these Islands, on the 1<sup>st</sup> October 2006 had in their possession the resin obtained from the plant Cannabis, or any other preparation of which such resin formed the base, in terms of Section 8(a) of the Chapter 101 of the Laws of Malta.

Having seen that both accused pleaded guilty as charged;  
Having seen Art. 8(a) of Chapter 101 of the Laws of Malta;

Having seen that both accused are first offenders and cooperated with the Police in their investigations;  
Finds them guilty as charged that of having on these Islands, on the 1<sup>st</sup> October 2006 had in their possession the resin obtained from the plant Cannabis, or any other preparation of which such resin formed the base, and conditionally discharges them according to the provisions of Art. 22 of Chapter 466 of the Laws of Malta, on condition that they do not commit another crime for the period of one year.

The Court orders the destruction of the resin found in the possession of the accused.

The Court also orders that a copy of this judgement together with the records of the case be sent to the Attorney General in accordance with Art. 401(3) of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta.
