The Court;

Having seen the charges brought against

Tabitha Ann Brown aged 25 years, daughter of Wayne and Janet nee' Biker, born in Australia on the 27th May, 1981, residing at 184 Hartfieod, London SW 19 3PQ and holder of Irish passport number W139360;

Kamal Jit Singh Gill aged 26 years, son of Atam Jit Sing Amd Manjit Kaur nee' Babra, born in London on the 11th September, 1980, residing at 55 Ashcombe Road, Wimbeldon SW19 8JP, London and holder of British passport number 028595659;

Informal Copy of Judgement

With having on the night between the 10th and 11th September, 2006, in St.Paul's Bay between 09:00hrs and 04:00hrs committed theft which amounts to more than Lm10 and less than Lm500 to the detriment of third parties;

Having seen the plea of guilt;

Having seen the records of this case;

Finds the accused guilty as charged;

Having seen articles 261 (c)(f), 267, 270 and 280 (1) of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta;

Having seen the clean conduct sheet of the accused and noted that all the stolen property was duly returned to the victims;

Condemns the accused to a term of imprisonment of six [6] months, which term shall not elapse unless the accused commit any other offence punishable with imprisonment within a period of two [2] years from today in terms of article 28A Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta.

The Court explained the meaning of this judgement to the accused and orders that these acts be transmitted to the attorney general within the time prescribed by law.
