The Court

Having seen the European Arrest Warrant issued by the competent judicial authorities of Rumania a scheduled country against Marius Vamanu, hereinafter known as “the person” for offences of trafficking in human beings and for sexual exploitation of children and child

pornography which offences are linked as scheduled offences in the said warrant which respect to which his surrender to Rumania is being sought.

Having seen the certificate issued by the Attorney General in the 29<sup>th</sup> October 2008 in accordance with article 7 of Legal Notice 320 of 2004.

Having seen the request for the person to be extradited made by the Court of Botosani.

Having seen all the acts.

Having considered

That, as can be seen from the record of proceedings of the sitting held in the 29<sup>th</sup> of October 2008, during the “initial hearing” the person in the presence of his defence and of the interpreter nominated by the Court, voluntarily declared that “....he is the same person specified in the European Arrest Warrant and “....is consenting to the (his) delivery to the requesting country”. In other words he consented to his extradition to the requesting country in accordance with article 43 of the above mentioned Legal Notice.

In view of the above and in accordance with article 45(2) and (3) of the same Legal Notice, the Court orders that the person, MARIUS VAMANU as described in the European Arrest Warrant, be kept under custody to await his extradition to Rumania which is to take place within ten (10) days from today. Finally, having seen articles 25 and 15(5) of the same Legal Notice as well as article 16 of the Extradition Act (Chapter 276 of the Laws of Malta), the Court is informing the person that if he feels that his human rights, have been, are being or are going to be infringed he has a right of redress under article 46 of the Constitution of Malta or under Chapter 319 of the Laws of Malta.
