The Court

Having seen that the accused

Omissis; and

Radu Stefan Lefter, 29 years old, born in Romania on the 25th of August 1980, son of unknown parents, residing in 2

Kopja Informali ta' Sentenza

Montperrier Gardens Triq ig-Gizimini Swieqi, holder of a Maltese Identity Card Number 37950A.

Were charged with having on the 7th February 2009 at about 12.00hrs from the Fish Farms tal-Mistra limits of Mellieha committed the theft of 105 kilogrammes of fish (seabass) having a value of 189 Euros to the detriment of Robert Aquilina and/or other persons which theft is aggravated by person and the nature of the things stolen.

Having seen sections 261(d)(g), 268 u 271 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta.

Having seen the consent of the Attorney General for this case to heard and tried summarily and that the accused had no objection to the case being so dealt with.

Having heard the accused plead guilty to the charge, this notwithstanding the fact that the Court warned him of the consequences of his plea and afforded to him sufficient time within which to withdraw his guilty plea.

Having seen the acts of the proceedings.

Having considered:

That the accused replied guilty to the charge brought against him consequently the charge is sufficiently proved.

That the accused co-operated with the competent authorities in their investigation and admitted the charge brought against him in the initial stages of the procedures.

That the accused has a clean criminal record.

For these reasons

The Court, after having seen sections 261(d)(g), 268 u 271 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta, on defendant's admission finds him guilty of the charge brought against him and by application of section 22 of Chapter 446 of the

Kopja Informali ta' Sentenza

Laws of Malta discharges him on condition that he does not commit an other offence within the period of one year.

The Court explained to the guilty party in ordinary language that if he commits an other offence during the period of one year he may be sentenced for the original offence.
