**Pektas Turan, 29 years, son of Vahap and Saliha nee  
Akgun, born in Turkey on the 15<sup>th</sup> October 1981, and  
residing at no: 14, Maple Leaf, Triq Tas-Salib, Mellieha  
holder of ID card No: 002857A**

The Court;

Having seen the charges brought against the accused Pektas Turan, with having on the 20<sup>th</sup> August, 2009, taken in his employment, or given work to, any person who is not an exempt persona and is not in possession of a licence granted to him for the purpose of such employment or work under the provisions of the Immigration Act, Chapter 217 of the Laws of Malta, or in

any way helped or assisted exempt persons in the carrying out of a premeditated crime and this in violation of Article 32(1)(b) of Chapter 217 of the Laws of Malta.

He is also being accused at the same date, time and circumstances, as the person responsible of the "Southern Fried Chicken" restaurant, Mellieha, for taking in his employment any person, who is not a Maltese citizen, who does not possess a valid and official work permit.

He is also being accused at the same date, time and circumstances as the employer of the person responsible for taking in his employment, full-time, part-time or otherwise, and whether under a definite or under an indefinite contract or probation, failed to inform the ETC of such employment in terms of Legal Notice 110 of 1993(3a to 10).

Having seen documents exhibited;

Having seen the Attorney General's consent;

Having heard the accused admit to the charges brought against him which admission of guilt was reaffirmed after being given sufficient time during which to reconsider the same;

Considers;

That in view of the admission of guilt the Court finds the accused guilty as charged.

In considering the punishment to be inflicted the Court is taking into consideration the early admission of guilt and the fact that the accused cooperated fully with the police during their investigations.

Consequently the Court after having seen Section 32(1)(b) of Chapter 217 and regulations 3a and 10 of Legal Notice 110 of 1993 finds the accused guilty as charged and condemns him to pay a fine of five hundred

euro (€500) which fine is to be paid in five (5) monthly installments of hundred euro (€100) each, the first payment will be due on the 31<sup>st</sup> January, 2010
