The Court;

Having seen the charges brought forward against **Waldemar Wiezik**, son of Romano and Vanda nee' Bugh, born on the 20th of July, 1959 in Resow Poland, having no fixed address and holder of Polish identity card no. 99433205;

Charged with having in these islands on the 25th February, 2010 at about half past three in the afternoon (03:30pm) in St. Julians:-

Committed theft of vehicle registration no. LCI 227 make Toyota, to the detriment of Guilia Camenzuli which theft is

aggravated by 'amount' (more than Euro 2,325.00), 'means' and 'nature of the thing stolen'.

Further for having on the same date, place, time and circumstances drove vehicle registration no. LCI-227 make Toyota without a valid driving licence.

The prosecution requests the Court that said accused be disqualified from holding any driving licence.

Accuse him for having committed a crime within the operative period of a suspended sentence which sentence was delivered on the 10th December, 2009 which sentence is final and cannot be revoked.

Having heard the plea of guilt;

Having seen the records of the case;

Finds the accused guilty as charged;

Having seen articles 261(c), 267 and 279(b), 28 B Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta and 15 (1)(a) of Chapter 65 of the said laws;

Having seen the judgement of the 10 December 2009 against the same accused, renders effective the term of imprisonment of six months therein stated and condemns the accused to a total term of imprisonment of thirteen (13) months from today. For the avoidance of doubt the six months imprisonment are included in the thirteen months total term.

The Court further orders that the accused be disqualified from holding any driving license within a period of six (6) months from the end of his term of imprisonment.

The Court orders that these acts be transmitted to the attorney general within the time ordained by law.
