**The Court;**

After seeing the charges brought against:

Ahmed Ali Said 30 years, son of Ahmed Ali and Sanyeb nee' nun, born Mogadisho Somalia, on the 1<sup>st</sup> January, residing at 19, Imriehel Street, B' Kara, bearing ID card number 0043463(A);

Informal Copy of Judgement

For Having on the 1<sup>st</sup> February 2010, at about 6.00pm at number 104, Msida Street B'kara and on these islands;

- 1) caused bodily harm on the person Mohamed Abdikadir Abdikadir of ID Card number 0032782(A) ai termini of Articles 214, 215, 216 and 218 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta;
- 2) for carrying, a knife or cutting or pointed instrument of any description without a licence or permit of the Commissioner ai termini of Chapter 480 Articles 6 and 7;
- 3) in any manner, wilfully disturbed the public good order or the public peace ai termini of Article 338 (dd) of Chapter 9;

**Considers:**

After having heard the evidence and the documents exhibited;

After having seen that the victim in this case, Mohammed Abdikadir, had fully reconciled with the accused, and that he no longer had any interest in this case and consequently wished to waive the charges against the accused;

After having seen that, in view of this amicable settlement, the accused was also waiving the charges against Mohammed Abdikadir in separate criminal proceedings, and that therefore the reconciliation between the parties was in fact complete;

After having heard the accused enter a plea of guilty at the earliest stage in the proceedings, and after having given the time prescribed by Law for the accused to consider his plea;

**For these reasons, therefore;**

After having seen the Articles 214, 215, 216, 218 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta; Articles 6 and 7 of Chapter 480, and Article 338 (dd) of Chapter 9;

This Court finds the said accused guilty as charged and condemns him to a term of one (1) year imprisonment suspended for two (2) years in accordance with Article 28A of Chapter 9 of the Law of Malta;

The Court explained in clear words the terms of the judgement to the accused.
