The Court,

Having seen that Henry Destiny Ehorobo, 34 years of age, son of Solomon and Esther, born in Benin City, Nigeria in 1976, Passport No: A 01498529, and currently residing at 20/2, St. Ignatius Street, Sliema.

Was charged with having on the 13th day of March, 2010 and in the previous days in Malta, associated himself together with other persons in Malta or outside Malta with the intention of committing a crime in Malta (Article 337A

of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta) which is punishable by imprisonment, and this in violation of Article 48A of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta.

Having seen sections 48A and 377A of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta.

Having heard the defendant admit the charge brought against him and confirm his admission of guilt even after having afforded him sufficient time to reconsider his position.

Having seen the acts of the proceedings.

Having heard the oral submissions made by the parties.

Having considered

That the accused replied guilty to the charge brought against him; the charge is consequently sufficiently proved.

That the accused co-operated with the competent authorities in their investigation and admitted the charges brought against him in the initial stages of the procedures.

For these reasons the Court, after having seen sections 48A and 337A of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta, on his admission finds defendant guilty of the charges brought against him and condemns him to one (1) year imprisonment.
