The Court,

Having seen the charges brought against the accused Hassan Mohamud Fatah holder of I.D. number 0031614(A) and Alien's passport number 9001279 and the accused Mohamed Abdikadir Abdikadir holder of I.D. number 032782(A) charged with on the 1<sup>st</sup> February, 2010 at about 06:00 p.m. at number 104, in Imsida Street, Birkirkara and on these Islands:

 having caused grievous bodily harm on the person of Ahmed Ali Said of I.D. card number 00043463(A) *ai termini* of Article 214, 215, 216 and 218 of Chapter 9.
in any manner, wilfully disturbs the public good order or the public peace *ai termini* of Article 338(dd) of Chapter 9.

The Court is requested, where it deems it expedient, in order to provide for the safety of individuals or for the keeping of the public peace, in addition to, or in lieu of the punishment applicable to the offence, require the offender to enter into his own recognizance in a sum of money to be fixed by the Court *ai termini* of Article 383 of Chapter 9.

Having seen the articles of law from the Attorney General;

Having heard the accused plead guilty to the charges on which guilty plea the accused insisted even after being given time to reconsider.

Finds the accused guilty of the charges brought against them.

Having seen Articles 214, 215, 216, 218, 338(dd) and 17 of Chapter 9 condemns each of the accused to a term of one year imprisonment which by application of Article 28A of Chapter 9 it suspends for 2 years provided the accused do not commit a further offence during the suspended term.

The Court explained to the accused their respective responsibilities according to judgment.
