The Court,

Having seen the charges brought against the accused Bubakar Camara of 22 years of age, Nationality Mali S/o (L) Suruba & (L) Nerega, born in Mali on 1<sup>st</sup> September 1988, residing in Marsa Open Centre, Police Boat number 08UU-003.

Charged with having on the 3<sup>rd</sup> of June 2010 and/or the previous days in Malta, forged altered or tempered with a passport/s or used or had in his possession a passport/s which he knew to be forged, altered or tempered with, one (1) Italian travelling document, one (1) Italian Identity Card and one (1) Italian Residence Permits. *Chapter 61 Section 5.*

Also charged with having on the same date and circumstances while in Malta, knowingly made use of a forged documents being the above mentioned passport/identity card and residence permit. *Chapter 9 Section 189.*

Also charged with having on the same date and circumstances and/or the previous days in Malta, made use of a false return, false statement or false representation and/or furnished the Principal Immigration Officer with false information. *Chapter 217 Section 32(1c).*

Therefore the Court is humbly requested to investigate the case according to Law.

Having heard the evidence tendered on oath;

Having heard the guilty plea registered by the accused;

Having heard the confirmation of the said guilty plea by the accused after the Court accorded the accused a reasonable time for reconsideration;

Having seen the record of the proceedings;

Having heard the oral submissions of the parties;

Deliberates:

On the strength of his own guilty plea, the Court finds the accused **Bubakar Camara** guilty as charged with the third (3) charge absorbed in terms of punishment, and after having seen Article 5 of Chapter 61 of the Laws of Malta, Article 189 and 28A of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta, Article 32(1c) of Chapter 217 of the Laws of Malta, **condemns the accused to six (6) months imprisonment suspended for one (1) year.**

This punishment was accorded after the Court took into consideration the early registration of the plea of guilt and clean conduct record of the accused.
