The Court,

Having seen the charges against Ouattara Anwar Sadat, son of Salif Mousa and Rahma, born in Ivory Coast on the 22nd January, 1986 known with Police number N 08EE-026,

Informal Copy of Judgement

For having on the 15th June 2009, escaped from a place of public custody, that is Safi Detention Centre.

And moreover for having in a date not know in July 2009, as a person landing or embarking in or from Malta, failed to be in possession of a passport and failed to provide the Principal Immigration Officer the prescribed information and such other information that the Principal Immigration Officer may deem proper to require.

Having section 151 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta and section 28 of Chapter 217 of the Laws of Malta.

Having seen the consent of the Attorney General for this case to be heard summarily and that the accused had no objection to the case being so heard.

Having seen that the accused admitted the charges brought against him and confirmed this admission of guilt even after having been given time to reconsider his plea.

Having seen the acts of the proceedings.

Having heard submissions regarding the penalty to be meted out.

Having considered

That the accused admitted the charges brought against him; these are subsequently sufficiently proved.

As regards the penalty to be meted out, the Court considered the nature of the offences of which the accused is being found guilty on the one hand and his clean conviction sheet on the other hand.

For these reasons the Court, after having seen section 151 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta and section 28 of Chapter 217 of the Laws of Malta, on his admission finds the accused guilty of the charges brought against him and condemns him to six (6) months imprisonment.
