Marat Abdullin**

The Court;

Having seen the charges brought against **Marat Abdullin**, 24 years of age, son of Nafiz Abdullin and Fanzeya Abdullin, born in USSR on 13th February 1988, residing at Blk A 7, Flt 1, Binja tal-Gvern, Pembroke, holder of Russian Federation passport number 63 no. 7739619

And accuse him with having on these islands on the night between the 3rd and 4th November 2012;

1. had in his possession the drugs (cocaine) specified in the First Schedule of the Dangerous Drug Ordinance, Chapter 101 of the Laws of

Malta, when he was not in possession of an import and export authorization issued by the Chief Governance Medical Officer in prrsuance of the provisions of paragraphs 4 and 6 of the Ordinance, and when he was not liscensed or otherwise authorised to manufacture or supply the mentioned drugs, and was not otherwised liscensed by the President of Malta or authorised by the internal Control fo Dangeroud Drugs Regulations (G.N. 295/1939) to be in possession of the mentuioned drugs, and failed to prove that the mentioned drugs was supplied to him for his personal use, according to a medical prescription as provdied in the said regulations, and this in breach of the 1939 Regulations, of the Internal Control of Dangerous Drugs Ordinance (G.N. 292/1939) as subsequently amended by the Drug Ordinance Chapter 101 of the Laws of Malta;

2. had in his possession (otherwise than in the course of transit through Malta of the territorial waters thereof) the whole of the plant Cannabis in terms of Section 8(d) of the Chapter 101 of the Laws of Malta;

Having seen the order of the attorney general in terms of article 22(2) of Chapter 101 of the Laws of Malta for the accused to be tried before this Court as a Court of Criminal Judicature;

Having heard the plea of guilt as registered by the accused during the first sitting held on the 5 November 2012;

Having seen the records of the case, find the accused guilty as charged;

Having seen article 8(d) and Section V and VI of Chapter 101 of the Laws of Malta and GN 292/1939;

Having seen the clean conduct sheet of the accused;

Conditionally discharges the accused with the condition that he does not commit any other offence which a term of

six (6) months from today in accordance with article 22 of Chapter 446 of the Laws of Malta;

The Court explained to the accused his obligations arising out of this judgement.

The Court also appoints scientist Godwin Sammut to destroy the exhibited drug Dok HM1.
