**The Court,**

Having seen that the accused known as Mian Imran Yousaf of British Nationality and holder of Passport number 509921990.

a) Was charged with having on the 3<sup>rd</sup> February 2013 in Malta MIA 15:00hrs forged altered or tempered with a passport/s or used or had in his possession two British passports namely one in the name of SEGAL SONIA 800707015 & SEGAL USMAN 464409214 which

he knew to be forged, altered or tempered with, Chap 61 Sec 5.

b) also charge him having with the same circumstances while in Malta, knowingly forged or made use of such documents being the above mentioned passports. Chap 9 Sec 189.

Having seen all documentation in relation to the case including the accused's medical situation.

Having seen consent of the Attorney General so that the case will be dealt with summarily.

Having seen that the accused admitted all charges brought against him and reconfirmed such plea after being given the opportunity to reconsider his plea.

By virtue of Section 5 Chapter 61 and Section 189 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta, finds accused Mian Imran Yousaf guilty of the charges brought against him and since second charge is comprised in the first and since there was an early plea and after having ascertained that his wife is expecting a child in the United Kingdom and that accused is suffering from psychological problems whereby he needs to receive medical treatment in the United Kingdom by virtue of Article 28A of Chap 9 condemns accused to eighteen (18) months imprisonment suspended for two and a half years.

Finally, explained in simple words the repercussions if such order is not complied with.
