## ANDREA GIULIANI

The Court,

Having seen the charges brought against Andrea Giuliani, son of Paolo and Adele nee Dossi born in the Italy on the 7<sup>th</sup> July 1987, residing at Belmonth Heights Block 1 Apartment number 4, Trejqet San Ignazju Sliema, holder of identity card with number 64463A.

Was charged with having during the weeks and months before the 14<sup>th</sup> of March 2012, from Caradon Crt Flat 1, Triq il-Wizna Swieqi.

1. Committed theft aggravated by value, which value exceeds two hundred and thirty-two euro and ninety-four cents (€232.94) but does not exceed two thousand and three hundred and twenty-nine euro and thirty-seven cents (€2,329.37) to the detriment of Peter Muscat Scerri.

2. Further more, with having on the same date, time and place and circumstances, willfully committed any spoil, damage or injury to or upon any movable or immovable property belonging to Peter Muscat Scerri, which the amount of the damage does not exceed one thousand and one hundred and sixty-four euro and sixty-nine cents ( $\in$ 1,164.69) but exceeds one hundred and sixteen euro and forty-seven cents ( $\in$ 116.47).

Seen the acts of the Case and the exhibited documents.

Seen the consent of the Attorney General exhibited as Dok LB1/Dok LB2 and noted that accused having been asked whether he objects to his case being tried summarily, replied that he has no objection to his case being tried summarily.

Noted that in today's Sitting in his examination accused replied that he is guilty of all the charges brought against him.

The Court warned accused in the most solemn manner as to the consequences of his admission of guilt and gave him some time to decide whether to confirm his admission of guilt or not, accused confirmed that he is guilty of all the charges brought against him.

Heard submissions on punishment.

Seen Sections 17, 261(c), 267, 279(a) and 325(b) of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta.

Taking into consideration that accused Andrea Giuliani pleaded guilty to all the charges brought against him, the Court finds said accused guilty of all the charges brought

against him and having considered all the circumstances of the Case, conditionally discharges accused Andrea Giuliani under the Provision of Section 22 of Chapter 446 of the Laws of Malta on condition that said accused Andrea Giuliani commits no offence during the period of three (3) years as from today.

Finally the Court is giving accused Andrea Giuliani the explanation prescribed in Sub-Section 22(3) of Chapter 446 of the Laws of Malta.
