TOMAS MIKALOUSKAS

The Court:

Having seen the accusations brought against the accused Tomas Mikalauskas , 31 years old, nationality Lithuanian, son of Atanas and Onute nee Mikuciauskaite, born in Kedainai (Lithuania) on the 21st August 1981, and residing at Flat 3, Rose Court, Annetto Caruana Street, St Paul's Bay, holder of Maltese Identity Card Number 67496A.

Accused that:

On these Islands, on the 24th June 2013 and in the preceding days and weeks, in various parts of Malta, by means of several acts committed by the accused, even if at different times, which acts constitute violations of the same provisions of the law;

1. For having, by means of any unlawful practice, or by the use of any fictitious name, or the assumption of any false designations, or by means of any other deceit, device or pretence calculated to lead to the belief in the existence of nay fictitious enterprise or of any imaginary power, influence or credit, or to create the expectation or apprehension of any chimerical event, made a gain of more than two thousand, three hundred and twenty nine Euro and thirty seven cents (€2,329.37) to the detriment of GO plc.

2. And with his actions, the accused failed to observe one of the conditions of bail imposed on same by Magst Dr M Hayman LL.D, when same was placed under bail conditions for having been granted bail.

The Court is also hereby requested that in case of a finding of guilt of the accused, apart from inflicting the punishment prescribed at Law, also orders the forfeiture of all the objects exhibited in these proceedings.

The Court:

Read the documents and accusations;

Heard the evidence produced under oath;

After having seen Articles 308 u 579 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta.

This Court finds the accused guilty and therefore condemns him to thirteen months imprisonment suspended for two years in terms of article 28A of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta.

Orders the accused to pay the amount decided to GO plc in terms of article 28H of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta
