The Court,

Having seen the charges against Henry Iyiegbu, 29 years old, son of Iyiegbu and Momogo born in Nigeria on the 29th of September, 1984 and residing in Msida, Malta and holder of police number 08TTT-062.

Charged with having in February, 2012 and the months after, while in Malta, landed or embarked from Malta without being in possession of a passport and not having furnished to the Principal Immigration officer the prescribed information and such other information as the Principal Immigration Officer may deem proper to require and this in violation of article 28 of Chapter 217 of the Laws of Malta.

Having seen article 28 of Chapter 217 of the Laws of Malta.

Having seen the consent of the Attorney General for this case to be tried summarily and that the defendant had no objection to the case being so tried.

Having seen that the defendant admitted the charge brought against him and confirmed this admission of guilt even after having been given time to reconsider his plea.

Having seen the acts of the proceedings.

Having heard the submissions regarding the penalty to be meted out.

Having considered

That the defendant admitted the charge brought against him; this is consequently sufficiently proved.

With regards to the penalty to be meted out the Court considered on the one hand the nature of the offence of which the defendant is being found guilty, and on the other hand his cooperation with the police and his admission at the earliest stage of these proceedings.

For these reasons the Court, after having seen article 28 of Chapter 217 of the Laws of Malta, on his admission finds defendant guilty of the charge brought against him and condemns him to three (3) months imprisonment.
