The **Court;**

After seeing the charges brought against:

Abdulkadir Ahmed Mohammed, 31 years, s/o Mohammed Ahmed and Hakima, b/Somalia on the 1<sup>st</sup> January 1982 and residing at 60, Fra Diego Street, Marsa, holder of ID Card no 30398A.

Charged;

1. On the 8<sup>th</sup> April 2013, at about 10:45p.m. in Marsa, caused grievous injuries on the person of Mubarak Aden David as certified by Dr. Jeffrey Bonnici M.D. of Mater Dei Hospital, which injuries were committed with arms proper or with a cutting or pointed instrument.
2. Had in his possession a knife or cutting or pointed instrument of any description without a license or permit from the Commissioner of Police;
3. Even though in a state of intoxication, publicly uttered any obscene or indecent words, or made obscene acts or gestures or in any way offended public morality, propriety or decency;
4. Wilfully disturbed the public good order or the public peace.
5. And also accused with having committed an offence (crime) during the operative period of a suspended sentence delivered by the Court of Magistrates on the 21<sup>st</sup> of March 2013, which sentence became definitive.

**Considers:**

After having seen the Article 216, 217, 338 (bb), 338 (dd) of Chapter 9 and Article 6 of Chapter 480 of the Laws of Malta;

After having seen the accused admit the charges brought against him, which admission was confirmed by him after having been given due time to reconsider in accordance with the law;

After having heard the evidence and the documents exhibited;

After having heard the accuser's plea and after having given the time prescribed by Law for the accused to consider his plea, this Court finds the said accused guilty as charged and condemns him to one (1) year imprisonment.

The Court furthermore abstains from making a provision in the suspended sentence issued on the 21 March, 2013, which therefore remains unchanged.

The Court explained in clear words the terms of the judgement to the accused.
