STOYAN MINEV

The Court:

Having seen the accusations brought against the accused Stoyan Minev, holder of Maltese Identity card number 33805A.

Accused that:

1. During the year 2012 and the year 2013 on these islands knowingly received or purchased any property which had been stolen, misapplied or obtained by means of any offence, mainly, two wrist watches of make Rolex and 2 antique pistols which collective value exceeds two thousand and three hundred and twenty nine euro and thirty seven cents (€2,329.37);
2. Kept in any premises or had in his possession, under his control or carried outside any premises or appurtenances any firearm mainly 2 pistols, without a licence under the Arms Act.

The Court:

Read the documents and accusations;

Heard the evidence produced under oath;

The Court after having seen the plea of the accused and after having seen his reconsideration of this plea, after having heard the parties vis-a-vis the penalty to be inflicted, considers that the voluntary admission of the accused to the charges brought against him by the Prosecution leaves this Court with no other alternative but to find the accused guilty as charged.

After having seen articles 334 of Chapter 9 and article 15(1) of Chapter 480 the Court finds the accused guilty and sentences him to a period of imprisonment of two (2) years, but with the application of article 28A of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta, the Court orders that this prison sentence will not be served if until within a period of four (4) years from

today the accused is charged and found guilty of another crime which carries with it a term of imprisonment.

The Court has explained the situation of this sentence to the accused Stoyan Minev.
