**The Court,**

Kopja Informali ta' Sentenza

Having seen that the accused Asowata Vivian, holder of Italian identity card bearing number AU0461469 and Belonwu Beneth holder of Maltese identity card bearing number 45066A.

Were charged with having:

That on the Maltese islands in Hgejjeg street, Saint Paul's Bay, Malta on the 5th May 2014 at about 12.20pm without the intention to kill or put the life of Nicola Romano ID: 107005L in danger they have caused him injuries of grievous nature, as certified by Dr. Michael Falemara Feyijimi MD registration number 5586 from Mater Dei Casualty department;

Art 218 of Chapter 9

Further accused that in the same date, place and circumstances they have wilfully damaged the glass pane of an aluminum door which damages amount to more than Euro 23.29 but less than Euro 116.47 to the detriment of Nicola Romano ID:107005L and/or other persons.

Art 325. (1) (c) of Chapter 9.

Further accused that in the same date, place and circumstances they have disturbed the public peace and order by fighting and shouting;

Art 338 (dd) of Chapter 9

Seen request by the prosecution that in case of guilt, to provide for the safety of Nikola Romano ID:107005L against a sum of money fixed by Court in terms of Article 383 ta' Kap 9. of the Laws of Malta;

After seen guilty plea by both the accused and the confirmation of such plea after being given the opportunity to reconsider their plea;

And after seeing Articles 218, 325(1)(c) and 383 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta, find accused Asowata Vivian and Belonwu Beneth guilty of all the charges brought against them and by virtue of Article 22 of Chapter 446 of the Laws Malta frees them on condition not to commit any offense in three (3) years time from today.

The Court also condemns accused to an order under Article 412C of the Laws of Malta attached to such judgment. The Court also orders accused to pay in solidum the sum of six hundred and thirty (€630) Euro to Nicola Romano

Finally explained in simply words to the accused, the repercussions is such order is not complied with.
