Today, the 28th of July, 2014

The Court,

Having seen the charges against Nickie Lottie Ida Bjelm, 23 years of age, daughter of Eric and Lottie nee' Carslon, born in Sweden on the 2nd of March, 1991, residing at Flat 5, Monterosa Flats, Sqaq is-Sigra, San Gwann and holder of Swedish passport number 81897015.

Charged with having on the 27th of July, 2014 in these Islands, had in her possession the psychotropic and restricted drug (ecstasy) without a special authorisation in writing by the superintendent of Public Health, in breach of the provisions of the Medical and Kindred Professions Ordinance, Chapter 31 of the Laws of Malta and the Drugs (Control) Regulations, Legal Notice 22 of 1985 as amended.

Having seen the Order of the Attorney General for this case to tried summarily by this Court as a Court of Criminal Judicature.

Having hear the defendant admit the charge brought against her and confirm her admission of guilt even after having been given time to reconsider her plea.

Having seen the documents filed by the prosecuting officer.

Having heard submissions regarding the penlaty to be meted out.

Having considered

That defendant admitted the charge brought against her; this is consequently sufficiently proven.

With regards the penalty to be meted out, the Court took into consideration on the one hand the nature of the offence of which defendant is being found guilty, and on the other hand the fact that defendant was found in possession of one pill, her cooperation with the police, her clean conviction sheet, and her admission at the earliest stage of these proceedings.

Wherefore the Court, after having seen Chapter 31 of the Laws of Malta and the Regulations of Legal Notice 22 of the year 1985, on her admission finds defendant guilty of the charge brought against her and by application of section 22 of Chapter 446 of the Laws of Malta is discharging her on condition that she does not commit an other offence in the period of one year. The Court is also ordering the destruction of the pill exhibited (Dok NS5) under the supervision of the Registrar of this Court.

The Court explained to the defendant in ordinary language the significance of this judgement and of the consequences should she commit an other offence in the period of one year.
