Informal Copy of Judgement

Having seen the charges brought against:

Eno Jegeni, 35 years of age, born in Albania on 07th September 1976, son of Suat and Shpreza nee' Rizvanolli residing at Apartment No. B23 Sundown Court, Triq ir-Russett, Kappara San Gwann and holder of Canadian Passport No. WB234379;

Eriks Petersons 24 years of age, born in Latvia on 24 of May 1987, son of Igors and Olga nee' Asachanko residing at No. 15 Ponsietta Court, Tower Street, Swatar and holder of Maltese of Identity Card No, 65081A;

Alberto Jose' Martinez Salini 26 years of age, born in Mexico on 20th of September 1985, son of Alberto and Laura nee' Salinas residing at Flat No. 2 San Andrea's Court, Triq I-Isperanto, Msida and holder of Mexican passport No. G06397467;

And charge them with having:

On the 31st of March 2012, on these Islands;

Had in their possession (otherwise than in the course of transit through Malta of the territorial waters thereof) the resin obtained from the plant Cannabis, or any other preparation of which such resin formed the base, in terms of Section 8 (a) of Chapter 101 of the Laws of Malta;

The Court is also requested to apply Section 533(1) of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta, as regards to the expenses incurred by the Court appointed Experts;

Having seen the consent of the attorney general given today for the proceedings to be decided by this Court;

Having seen Section 8 (a) of Chapter 101, as well as Section 22(1) of Chapter 446;

Having heard their admission as well as the declaration by the prosecution that the accused cooperated fully with the Police,

Having seen the clean conduct sheet of the accused;

Discharges the accused with the specific condition that they do not commit any other offence within a period of eighteen (18) months from today in terms of article 22 of Chapter 446 of the Laws of Malta.

The Court also orders the destruction of documents N, M and O in the presence of the Registrar of Courts.
