The Court;

Having seen that the offender **Oredia Isaal** was charged with having on the 1st February 2015 and in the previous days in Malta:

Informal Copy of Judgement

While having in his possession a Travel document, Identity Card and Residence Permit issued by a competent authority, that is Italy bearing numbers 43629, AU0167397 and I01484492, issued in the name of Husein Mamudu, had transferred this document to another person or received this document which was transferred to him by another person (Cap 61, Sec 3 of the Laws of Malta);

And also charged with having on the same date, time and circumstances made use or attempted to make use of the mentioned documents, issued to another person (Cap 61, Sec 4 of the Laws of Malta);

And also charged with having on the same date, time and circumstances made false return, false statement or false representation to the Principal Immigration Officer (Cap 217, Sec 32(1c) of the Laws of Malta).

After having seen all the records of the case;

After having heard the offender plead guilty to the charges brought against him at an early stage of these proceedings, which guilty plea was confirmed by the same offender after the Court warned him of the legal consequences of that guilty plea and allowed him sufficient time to re-consider his reply, and to change it;

After having seen the consent of the Attorney General so that the case be dealt with summarily;

After having heard the oral submissions on the punishment;

From the evidence brought forward and from the guilty plea registered by the offender himself, the Court concludes that the offender is guilty of the charges laid against him.

As regards the punishment, the Court took into consideration the fact that the offender admitted to the charges at a very early stage of the proceedings, that he co-operated with the police, and he has a clean conviction sheet and that according to the Police Inspector he has valid documents to stay in Italy which documents however were not in the accused's possession at the time he was apprehended by the Police.

For these reasons the Court, after having seen sections 3 and 4 of Chapter 61 of Laws of Malta and section 32 (1) (c) of Chapter 217 of the Laws of Malta, on his admission finds the offender **Oredia Isaal** guilty of all the charges brought against him and condemns him to three (3) months imprisonment.
