The Court;

Having seen the charges brought against

**Piotr Stefan Roznerski** Polish ID Card number AZK406948; and

**Monika Piotrowska** Czeck Republic ID Card number 200745052

Accused with having in these island on the 19<sup>th</sup> September, 2015 at about 02:50hrs:

- 1) Committed an offence against decency or morals, by any act committed in a public place or in a place exposed to the public (Act 209 Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta);
- 2) Accused them further for having on the same date, time, place and circumstances exposed themselves naked or were indecently dressed (Art. 3389q) Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta).

Having heard the accused plead guilty to the charges brought against them, notwithstanding the fact that the Court warned them of the consequences of their guilty plea after having afforded them sufficient time within which to withdraw their guilty plea, the Court has no alternative but to find them guilty of the charges brought against them.

With regards to punishment the Court took into consideration the fact that the accused filed an early guilty plea and also the fact that they are first time offenders.

For the abovementioned reasons and after having seen section 17, 209 and 338(q) of the Criminal Code the Court finds both the accused guilty of all the charges brought against them and on terms of Section 22 of Chapter 446 of the Laws of Malta

discharges them subject to the condition that they do not commit another offence within twelve (12) months from today.
