Today, the 21st of March, 2016

The Court,

Having seen that the accused Francesca Nadin, holder of Identity Card Number 65674A.

Was charged with having:

- 1) On the 16th October 2013, and in the previous months, in Malta, without authorization used a computer or any other device or equipment to access any data, software or supporting documentation held in that computer or on any other computer, or uses, copies or modifies any such data, software or supporting documentation in breach of Article 337C(1)(a) of the Criminal Code Chpt. 9;
- 2) On the 16th October 2013, and in previous months, in Malta, without authorization used another person's access code, password, user name, electronic mail address or other means of access or identification information in a computer, in breach of Article 337C(1)(i) of the Criminal Code Chpt. 9; and
- 3) On the 16th October 2013, and in the previous months, in Malta, intercepted by technical means, non-public transmissions of data, to, from or within a computer system, including electromagnetic emissions from a computer system carrying such computer data in breach of Article 337C(1)(k) of the Criminal Code Chpt. 9.

Seen documentation; including the Consent of Attorney General so that the case will be dealt with summarily;

Seen Articles 337C(1)(a), 337C(1)(i) and 337C(1)(k) of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta; and

Heard evidence and guilty plea by the accused for the charges brought against her, and the confirmation of such plea after being given the opportunity to reconsider her plea, finds accused Francesca Nadin guilty of all the charges brought against her and by virtue of Article 22 of Chapter 446 of the Laws of Malta frees her with the condition no to commit another offence within 2 years from today.

Finally, explained in simple words to the accused, the repercussions if such order is not complied with.
